Dr. Reddy received her master's and doctoral degrees from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, where she specialized in complex societies, South Asian archaeology, and paleoethnobotany. Her recent book, *Discerning Palates of the Past*, published through the International Monographs in Prehistory (University of Michigan, 2003), uses ethnoarchaeology, paleoethnobotany, and carbon-isotope analysis to model Indus Valley agricultural systems.

Since 1994, Dr. Reddy has focused her research on California prehistory, hunter-gatherer subsistence systems and human behavior. She has conducted extensive archaeological research in India and California. Dr. Reddy also provides consulting services in paleoethnobotany.
